Letter of Continuing Guaranty: PAA SANITIZER

Spartan Chemical Company, Inc., as the manufacturer of PAA Sanitizer, guarantees that this product is safe and effective for use in food processing plants, including USDA inspected facilities, when used as directed on the product labeling and this letter. When used in this manner this product will not adulterate food product or create unsanitary conditions.

PAA Sanitizer is a peroxyacetic acid based no-rinse sanitizer for food contact surfaces. PAA Sanitizer can be used as a sanitizer for casing, shell or hatching eggs. PAA Sanitizer can be used in water or ice that contacts raw or fresh, post-harvest or further processed fruit and vegetables to control the growth of non-public health microorganisms that may cause decay and spoilage.

PAA Sanitizer:

- Is registered with the US EPA as Reg. No. 63838-1-5741
- Complies with 21 CFR Section 178.1010 "Sanitizing Solutions"
- Conforms to Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS)'s "**Sanitation Performance Standards Compliance Guide**"
- Meets the profile of USDA's former "D2" "Sanitizers for all surfaces not always requiring a rinse".
- Meets the profile of USDA's former "Shell Egg Sanitizing Compound".
- Controls the growth of non-public health microorganisms that may cause decay and spoilage in water or ice that contacts raw or fresh, post-harvest processed fruit and vegetables in commercial operations and packinghouses.

Before using PAA Sanitizer, food products and packaging materials must be removed from the area or carefully protected. A potable water rinse is not required following the use of this product in official establishments, provided that the equipment and utensils are adequately drained before contact with food, so that little or no residue remains which can adulterate or have a deleterious effect on edible products.

PAA Sanitizer is acceptable as a sanitizing agent for shell eggs when incorporated into a warm potable water spray rinse for use in sanitizing clean or freshly washed eggs. The solution must be equal to or warmer than the eggs, but not to exceed 130° F. Wet eggs thoroughly and allow to drain. Eggs that have been sanitized with this product may be broken for use in the manufacture of egg products without a prior potable water rinse. Eggs must be reasonably dry before casing or breaking. The sanitizing solution must not be reused for sanitizing eggs. For hatching eggs apply the sanitizing solution as eggs are gathered or prior to setting using a spray or flood so as to lightly wet egg shell surfaces. Allow to drain dry.

Carefully read and follow all statements on the labeling and Safety Data Sheet while using this product.
