

# List N: Spartan Disinfectants for Use Against SARS-CoV-2

On March 13, 2020 the EPA published List N: Disinfectants for Use Against SARS-CoV-2. List N includes products that meet EPA's criteria for use against SARS-CoV-2, the cause of COVID-19. This list includes products with emerging viral pathogen claims and those with human coronavirus claims.

### **Emerging Viral Pathogen Policy**

The EPA has been overwhelmed by applications for the Emerging Viral Pathogen Policy amendment and thus has published the following guidance as it relates to List N, disinfectants, and SARS-CoV-2.

When purchasing a product, check if its EPA registration number is included on this list. If it is, you have a match and the product can be used against SARS-CoV-2. You can find this number on the product label – just look for the EPA Reg. No. These products may be marketed and sold under different brand names, but if they have the same EPA registration number, they are the same product.

# How to find the EPA registration number on Spartan products

To find the EPA registration number on Spartan products, look directly below the Active Ingredients listing. You will see that the registration number for HALT (1018, 4806) is 10324-93-5741. While the Halt brand name is not listed on List N, you will find a match for 10324-93. The suffix "5741" is Spartan's EPA establishment number.
