THE EPA


- Registers disinfectants for efficacy and safety
- Regulates all aspects of testing, registering, labeling, and marketing of surface sanitizers and disinfectants



THE EPA'S LIST N

Approved disinfectant products that kill the COVID-19 virus when used as directed.





PRODUCT INFORMATION

PRODUCT LABEL

Always follow the label!

- EPA registration number ensures products are tested and approved to kill the listed organisms
- Wear gloves or other label-recommended PPE
- Follow dilution instructions to ensure correct potency
- To ensure efficacy, be sure surface remains wet for the contact time listed on the label
- Apply disinfectants only as directed on the label. If an application is not included (spraying, immersion, or fogging), then don't use it!



SAFETY DATA SHEETS

SDSs explain the hazards, precautions, and response actions for a particular disinfectant and detail proper medical or first aid treatments, should overexposure occur.

 Employers must ensure that SDSs are readily accessible to employees for all hazardous chemicals in their workplace.



SDS INFORMATION INCLUDES:

- A product's physical and chemical properties
- Hazards identification, first aid measures, and handling, storage and transport information

EFFICACY BULLETINS



- Describe the tests performed by the manufacturer to register the product with the EPA
- List the product's efficacy as a disinfectant or sanitizer
- List the organisms that the product kills, with contact time and dilution for complete efficacy
